

About the Artist Roger W. Price



Roger is a fine artist, photographer, and custom leather craftsman. He is a United States Army, Gulf War Era Veteran who served as an infantry soldier, engineer, and Army illustrator. As a fine artist, he works primarily with acrylic, but is also familiar with oils, watercolor, and paints. He is best known for paintings depicting historical “Black and Brown” Soldiers, Sailors and Marine units of the United States Armed Forces. Units like the 9th & 10th Cavalry Divisions, “Buffalo Soldiers,” the 332nd Fighter Group, “Tuskegee Airmen,” and the 6888th “Central Postal Directory Battalion.”

His works include paintings of United States Military Forces engaged in the Korean, Persian Gulf, and Bosnian Wars. As a member of the Army Artist Team, he created original works of art that were added to the U.S. Army’s Center of Military History collection and the United States National Archives in Washington D.C. Roger’s paintings have shown in juried art shows and private exhibitions in Germany, France, South Korea and the United States. They are also found in private and public collections across the United States, Germany, and wherever the American Military serves. His painting “Forging the Peace South of the Sava” was commissioned for the U.S. Army’s First Armored Division and took Roger to a firebase outside of Tuzla, Bosnia in the former Soviet Union in 1998.

A sought after artist, commissioned to create paintings for United States Military units, commercial companies, higher education institutions, the United States Post Office, and the NBA World Champions, the San Antonio SPURS.

Roger has appeared on American Forces Network Television Europe (AFN-E), American Forces Korea Network (AFKN), featured in newspaper and magazine articles, most recently the Pilot Newspaper, and on the cover of the More County (North Carolina) Arts Council magazine. His paintings have been featured on book and magazine covers, and online articles in the United States, Germany, and South Korea.

As a photographer, Roger’s skillful eye expertly captures subjects for his landscapes and floral paintings. His images have won several awards and placed in local, regional and national level competitions. As a custom leather craftsman, he has created unique one-of-a-kind hand-crafted pieces of fine art, and messenger bags, purses, gun holsters and related products.

Roger’s art is as diverse as he is, from beautiful florals and golf courses to powerful, emotion-filled musicians to paintings of key historical figures, to everyday people. His portrait work includes local public officials, professional athletes, and historic cultural figures. He has a unique way of capturing life in motion and uses his artistic expression as a storyteller who shares the journeys of those that came before, those still writing their own stories and of the beauty of life all around us.
